Special Offerings This Year in Seattle: Consumer Class Action Symposium and Bankruptcy Intensive

Class Action Symposium: This year, NCLC's 22nd annual Class Action Symposium will include five or six 60-90 minute sessions on topics of specific interest to experienced consumer class action practitioners. We will address evolving changes and emerging developments in class action practice, including: noteworthy court of appeals rulings; evidentiary challenges and opportunities; developments in class administration; and new ethical issues of particular importance in complex litigation cases.

Bankruptcy Intensive: Be prepared to help your clients when COVID-19 relief measures no longer provide protection and debt collection increases. Designed for attorneys new to bankruptcy practice, this intensive will take you through the steps of handling your first bankruptcy cases. This course will cover the fundamentals and help you understand what is possible in bankruptcy. You will learn why bankruptcy can be an effective way to help clients stop medical, credit card and other debt collection, and to prevent creditor actions such as wage garnishment, home foreclosure, and car repossession. Topics will include: counseling the consumer client; gathering the necessary information; key bankruptcy concepts (means test, exemptions, automatic stay, discharge); preparing the required documents; attorney duties; and dealing with secured debt. It will also include an overview of how Chapter 13 bankruptcy can be used to save a client's home from foreclosure.
