In 2016, he won a \$10 million dollar verdict against an abusive debt collector. Nick is a 2008 graduate of Harvard Law School. After graduating, Nick clerked for the Honorable Edward L. Chavez on the New Mexico Supreme Court. Before joining Feferman, Warren & Mattison, Nick worked for four years in the Window Rock office of DNA-People's Legal Services, where he fought for the rights of people living in poverty in the four corners region. Before becoming a lawyer, Nick was an elementary school teacher on the Navajo Nation.
